Email Extension Change: .net to .org



Earlier this year we launched our new website at assets-school.org. We transitioned from a `.net' extension to a `.org' extension for two main reasons:

The `.org' extension indicates that we are a nonprofit organization.
The `.org' extension has a better Google and key word ranking than `.net,' which means our website will be more easily searchable.

To ensure consistency across platforms, we also changed all school email address extensions (faculty, staff and students) to @assets-school.org before the start of this school year. If you have any `.net' addresses stored in your contact list, please update them.
